The Goal

- ~ Create a pool of highly qualified and motivated administrators to fill superintendent vacancies in Ohio's Career and Technical school districts.
- ~ Assist those new to the position of superintendent, to successfully transition to the role of the CTE superintendency.
- ~ Assist experienced superintendents new to Career and Technical Education, to gain an understanding of the nuances and differences of CTE, and to successfully transition to the role of the CTE superintendency.
- ~ Assist central office administrators gain a broader understanding of district operations experienced through the role of the Career Center/JVSD superintendent.



The Need

The 49 superintendents, who serve as chief executive officers (CEO's) of Ohio's Career Centers/JVSDs, are expected to possess the skills of a comprehensive superintendent plus those associated with CTE, including working collaboratively with workforce development.
